
Region 3 Behavioral Health Services is writing to request a final Alternative Compliance extension for Fiscal Year 2027 (July 1, 2026 through December 10, 2026) for Revive, Inc. to 206 NAC 4- 001, Accreditation, which requires provider agencies to hold national accreditation as a Behavioral Health Provider. The Division of Behavioral Health approved the initial Alternative Compliance request on March 22, 2024, for Fiscal Years 2024-2025 (July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2025). An extension of the Alternative Compliance was approved for Fiscal Year 2026 (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026) due to delays in service implementation. Revive, Inc.'s current Alternative Compliance is set to expire on June 30, 2026.

In January 2026, Revive Inc. provided an update indicating that a CARF application had been submitted and that an onsite survey would be scheduled approximately six months after full program implementation. At that time, it was anticipated that all programs would be operational within a few months. Based on the current timeline, Region 3 is requesting a final Alternative Compliance from the Division of Behavioral Health (DBH) for the period of July 1, 2026 through December 10, 2026. This timeframe is intended to provide Revive, Inc. with the opportunity to complete the accreditation process.

As Region 3 Behavioral Health Services Provider Network maintains CARF accreditation, all providers within the network are required to either hold national accreditation or actively work toward it, with completion expected within two years of becoming a Region 3 Network Provider.

Region 3 Behavioral Health Services strives to increase affordable and accessible behavioral health services to individuals residing within the Region 3 service area. This final Alternative Compliance would allow Revive, Inc. to remain a Region 3 Network Provider while assuring that they are meeting all standards and requirements of a non-accredited provider, in order to provide the highest quality of service while meeting all of Region 3 and the Division of Behavioral Health standards. Region 3 will continue to provide oversight with the expectation that Revive, Inc. must complete the CARF survey process by December 10, 2026.
