



**Alternative Compliance Ratification for Revive, Inc.
Effective July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2025**

**Approval by Rich Nelson, Chairperson on March 22, 2024
Approval by the Division of Behavioral Health on March 28, 2024
Ratification by the Regional Governing Board on May 24, 2024**

Alternative Compliance

A community-based behavioral health provider can request an Alternative Compliance Request (ACR) from the Division of Behavioral Health for various regulations set forth in 206 Nebraska Administrative Code Behavioral Health Services as deemed appropriate to further the development and implementation of recovery-oriented and person-centered community-based behavioral health services. The Regional Governing Board must approve the request when the provider is under contract with the Regional Behavioral Health Authority.

Region 3 requested an ACR for 206 NAC Chapter 6 Section 015, for Revive Inc. to allow Revive Inc. to become a Region 3 Network Provider and to open the opportunity to provide services before their ability to become nationally accredited. Revive Inc. anticipates beginning to provide services 07-2024. This Alternative Compliance allows Revive Inc. to become a Region 3 Network Provider while assuring that they are meeting all of Region 3 and the Division of Behavioral Health's' Network Provider Standards. Region 3's projected FY24 contract with Revive Inc. will be in the amount of \$102,715.

Therefore, Region 3 on behalf Revive Inc. requested a two-year AC effective July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025. In lieu of national accreditation, Region 3 will utilize network accreditation processes to oversee the quality of service delivery by Revive Inc.

Revive Inc. received approval via a letter dated March 22, 2024 by Tony Green, Interim Director of the Division of Behavioral Health the two-year period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025.

I am requesting that the Regional Governing Board ratify the approval of the Alternative Compliance Request.
